

LOUISIANA TRAPSHOOTING HALL OF FAME

MARSHALL V. SANSON



Marshall V. "Shon" Sanson began his registered trap shooting career in 2009 at Pine Hills Gun Club in West Monroe, Louisiana. Shon is a medical doctor specializing in family practice and owns Sanson Family Medicine, a large medical clinic in West Monroe. Shon is married to Jodi Sellers Sanson, who has also registered ATA targets, as has their daughter, Sarah Sellers.

Shon became involved in registered trap shooting at a time when the LTA was struggling with declining state shoot attendance and declining income due to reduced shooting. Shon, who has been a strong supporter of youth shooting, stepped in to assist the association and youth shooters by sponsoring complimentary entry fees and free ammunition for thirty youth shooters per year at the state shoot for several years. These shooters sponsored by Dr. Sanson often comprised more than one third of the shooters in the state shoot singles event.

Shon further supported the state shoot by having his clinic become the sponsor of the championship singles for several years. He further supported the LTA and the state

shoot by becoming the sponsor of the Saturday night complimentary meal for shooters and their families for several years.

Shon served as a director of the LTA and was eventually elected Louisiana's ATA delegate and served in that capacity for three years before he stepped down. For the past two years, Shon has served as a director of the LTA.

In addition to his work on behalf of the trap shooters of Louisiana and his financial support of the state shoot and of the LTA, Shon also had a very successful shooting career. He has won a number of ATA trophies at our state shoot, including runner-up in the singles and doubles events, and he has won trophies at the Grand American. Shon is also a two time Louisiana State Helice Champion.

The LTA is proud to induct Shon into the LTA Hall of Fame in recognition of his service to the association, to the shooters of Louisiana and of his shooting career.
