LTA Board Meeting - September 29, 2018

The meeting was called to order by President, Keith Crissman, at 11:00 am.

Those in attendance were:

Keith Crissman Donny Sanders Jim Jenkins Doyle Brooks Mitch Killingsworth Al Sikes Danny Batten

Johnny Pollard's proxy was given to Keith Crissman. Shon Sanson's proxy was given to Jim Jenkins

- 1. A safety moment was reviewed in regard to fire extinguisher locations and room exits. What to do in the event of a medical emergency was discussed.
- 2. Keith recognized the TBMGC team for their effort on the 2018 state shoot.
- 3. The financials were reviewed. The 2018 year ended with a surplus of \$1527. There has been a loss of the Championship Singles Event and one of the Preliminary Event donors. There are several extraordinary costs that won't be incurred this year. A preliminary budget, reflecting the anticipated donors and expenses was presented that reflects an anticipate surplus of \$910 assuming that the number of targets thrown remain the same and that trophy and printing costs don't increase. Everyone was encouraged to search for additional donors.
- 4. The number of targets thrown for 2018 were reviewed against those thrown in 2017. There was a small reduction in the total number of targets thrown for the state; however, the state shoot numbers increased about 50%. Targets next year should increase if Bridgeview begins throwing targets again.
- 5. The dates for the 2019 state shoot were approved to be 5/2

through 5/5 with Thursday being Open and Friday through Sunday being Resident/ Non-resident.

- 6. It was approved to reorder Friday to doubles, handicap, then singles to allow the determination of handicap shootoffs to have more time.
- 7. Trophy Committee Keith and Doyle and others to help as available were approved. Keith
- 8. In regard to keeping/ eliminating options due to low utilization, it was decided to keep track of 50/ 100 options again for 2019 and analyze the result to determine if we need to eliminate any options for 2020.
- 9. It was decided to leave target fees at \$36/100 until additional event donors are obtained.
- 10. It was decided to name Thursday events for last year's championship event winners.
- 11. The proposed slate of Board members for next year was approved for the incumbents except Al Sikes will be replaced with Gene Saizon. Al is moving out of state.
- 12. The HOF committee proposed that Donny Sanders be selected to the 2019 Hall of Fame. This was unanimously approved. Congratulations were given to Donny.
- 13. To reduce the effort associated with maintaining the lifetime targets list, which is only used for HOF consideration, any individuals who move out of state will be dropped from the list. This will allow cut and paste of the totals from the ATA data. Deceased LTA members will continue to be listed.
- 14. In regard to updating the Articles of Incorporation and Bylaws, the proposed changes by Chuck Traylor and Jim Jenkins were accepted as follows and will be presented at the 2019 State Members meeting for a membership vote:
 - a. The member meeting language will be revised to state the membership meeting will be held Saturday or Sunday at the state shoot and will be published as to the date in the shoot program.
 - b. The Board meeting at the state shoot language will be revised to reflect Board meetings will be revised for the Board to meet as determined by the Board. Currently the Board meets in August or September and not at the state shoot.
 - c. The requirement to select the state shoot location for the next year at the state shoot will be eliminated. The Board takes proposals for locations at the fall Board meeting and makes the determination then. The trend is to give multiple year commitments for the shoot due to the high cost of hosting the shoots and preparing for them.
 - d. The requirement of having five fields to hold the state shoot will be eliminated.
 - e. The requirement to have a separate HOF account with 3 authorized check writers will be replaced by having a separate HOF accounting with the checking account check writers only required. This removes the need to have a separate savings account, which generates interest of a small amount, which in turn requires a detailed tax return to be filed.

- 15. Other Business
 - a. A new trap club, the Lafayette Tarp Club, in Kaplan, LA will be holding shoots soon. The paperwork with the ATA is in progress.
 - b. Due to the unknowns with the renovations being held at Bridgeview, their shoot dates will not be held. Keith will check on who will run future shoots for Bridgeview.
 - c. The Board meeting will be the 3rd Saturday in August, 2019 to allow more time for trophy ordering.
 - d. Pre-squadding can we pre-classify prior to start of state shoot. Probably not.
 - e. Number of shooters in state Al discussed 4H / AlM might be able to help. David Hebert supporting youth shooting. 4H in Natchitoches has 114 shooters with LSU providing shells. Maybe an AIM director needs to be appointed to move it forward. Keith will check with 4H; Doyle will check on AIM information.
 - f. The use of the a credit card at the state shoot was tabled. JJ to investigate why Options can't be charged to a credit card.
 - g. Al brought up the potential to add additional lighted fields to allow normal shooting to continue during the state shoot for greater number of shooters. The two fields currently lighted handle the shootoff requirements.

 - d. With same number of targets thrown, a \$1 drop in target cost reduces revenue by \$740.

This is how we are doing the HOF funds now. We had a separate account but the banks insisted on paying interest which would force us to file a more detailed tax return, which we don't want to do.

Re: Possible revisions to LTA articles and by-laws

Dear Jim,

Pursuant to the mission given to me by President McPhate during the state meeting in May, 2018, I've taken a look at the articles and by-laws of the LTA and I would like to make a couple of suggestions for possible amendments or revisions to bring our corporate governing documents more in line with the current needs of the LTA.

Annual Meeting

Article VIII of the Articles of Incorporation currently provides that the annual meeting of the membership of the LTA is to be held "between the morning and afternoon shooting rounds on the Saturday during" the state shoot.

This provision has proven problematic in recent years due to increasing attendance and the limited number of traps available at the host club which requires that there be no break between the hundreds on Saturday in order to get the singles championship shot before dark. Last year, and in prior years, this sort of problem was often handled by calling the meeting to order and immediately adjourning it until some more convenient time later during the state shoot.

The LTA can continue to deal with this problem in this manner or Article VIII may be amended to provide more flexibility. The first sentence of Article VIII could be amended to read as set out below:

The annual meeting of the membership of this Corporation shall be held on Saturday and/or Sunday of the annual state shoot. The meeting may be adjourned from time to time but must be completed by the beginning of the final championship event on Sunday. The time of the meeting shall be announced in the state shoot program.

This approach would give the Board more flexibility in selecting a time for the meeting and would make abundantly clear that it is permitted to adjourn and resume the meeting if need be. It would require that the meeting be completed before the handicap championship begins on Sunday. It would also require that the time of the meeting be announced in the state shoot program.

A second problem area in Article VIII or the Articles concerns the business to be handled at the annual meeting. The second sentence of the Article states that one of the matters to be handled at the annual meeting is to "... designate the dates and location for the annual State trapshooting tournament (Louisiana State Shoot) for the following year ..."

As you know, this has not been the practice of the LTA for at least twenty years. During that time, the LTA Board has chosen the dates and site for the state shoot. This change in practice came about by necessity as many years ago we reached a point where no potential host clubs would request to host the state shoot at the annual meeting.

In order to bring the provisions of the Articles in line with the actual ongoing practice of the LTA, I suggest that we amend Article VIII to remove the language concerning selection of the state shoot date and location from the second sentence of Article VIII.

If the Board considers it appropriate to seek these amendments to Article VIII they can be presented to the membership at the 2019 annual meeting. However, that means that at the 2019 State shoot the Board will need to be ready to deal with the problem of the time of the state meeting in the manner in which it was handled this year by briefly calling the meeting to order and recessing to a more convenient time on Sunday.

Requirement for five fields for a State Shoot host club

Article II.D. of the LTA By-Laws includes a provision that reads "No gun club will be allowed to host the Louisiana State Shoot unless it has five or more fully equipped regulation trap fields." This provision has been suspended by a vote of the membership at the 2016 state meeting until such time as there are at least two Louisiana clubs with at least five fields but it remains part of our by-laws.

As there are currently no Louisiana clubs with five or more fully equipped regulation trap fields, this restriction appears likely to remain suspended for the foreseeable future. However, in order to permanently provide the Board the greatest flexibility in holding state shoots, it may be desirable to amend Article II.D. by simply deleting the first sentence. This would permanently remove the five field requirement.

Conclusion

These problems can be dealt with by amending the Articles and By-Laws at the 2019 state meeting if the Board determines that such is desirable. I will be happy to assist in preparation of the language of the amendments if the Board desires.

I appreciate the opportunity to look into these issues and to write this report for the Board.
